

**Required Documentation: Developmental Disability**

<p>A signed psychological assessment(s) from a licensed psychologist, certified school psychologist, licensed physician, including a developmental pediatrician or psychiatrist, licensed physician's assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner, indicating a diagnosis of developmental disability (defined as a condition of substantial developmental delay or specific congenital or acquired conditions with a high probability of resulting in an intellectual disability or autism spectrum disorder, the disability manifested prior to the age of 9 and the disability is likely to continue indefinitely.)</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
