
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NUMBER 24

AND NOW, this 11<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1986, it is hereby ordered that no case pending before any appellate court shall be marked discontinued or settled by the Prothonotary, Clerk of Courts or the Register of Wills until a disposition by the appellate court shall have been received and docketed or written notice of discontinuance from the appellate prothonotary shall have been received and docketed.
