ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #28

AND NOW, this *20<sup>th</sup>* day of *MARCH*, 1987, in accordance with the Child Protective Services Act, 11 Pa. C.S. §2201 et seq., as amended by Act No. 1985-33, whenever an adoption investigation is made pursuant to 23 Pa. C.S. §2535(c), the Report of Investigation filed with the Clerk of the Orphans Court shall be required to contain:

1. A report of criminal history from the Pennsylvania State Police;
- and
2. A certification from the Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare certifying that the applicant(s)/proposed adoptive parent(s) are not registered as the perpetrator(s) of a founded or indicated report of child abuse.

This Order shall become effective thirty (30) days after publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
