PA DEP (Department of Environmental Protection)	Recycling Performance Grants	The grants awards are based on the total tons recycled and the applicant's recycling rate. Post-consumer aluminum and steel cans, glass, plastics, corrugated cardboard, newspapers and other marketable grades of paper are materials eligible for the grants. All eligible materials collected from residents, business, schools, colleges, universities and community events can be factored into the grant awards. PA DEP (Department of Environmental Protection)	Certified Host Municipality Inspector Reimbursement (for Commercial Hazardous Waste Facilities)	Grants are available to municipalities that host commercial hazardous waste storage, treatment or disposal facilities. They are eligible for reimbursement of up to 50% of the approved costs for employment of certified host municipality inspectors. PA DEP (Department of Environmental Protection)	Certified Host Municipality Inspector Reimbursement (for Municipal Waste Facilities)	Grants are available to municipalities that host municipal landfills or resource recovery facilities. They are eligible for reimbursement of up to 50% of the approved costs for employment of certified host municipality inspectors. PA DEP (Department of Environmental Protection)	Host Municipality Review of Permit Applications Grants	Grants are available to municipalities for assistance with independent reviews of permit applications for new municipal waste landfills or resource recovery facility, or expansion of an existing facility. PA DEP (Department of Environmental Protection)	Host Municipality Independent Review of Permit Application/Siting Plan Grants	Grants are available to host municipality and host county inspectors for the independent review of permit applications for commercial hazardous waste disposal facilities. PA DEP (Department of Environmental Protection)	Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program Grant	Grants are available to registered sponsors of collection programs for household hazardous waste (HHW), electronics, and tires (but not tire pile cleanups). Reimbursement is available for up to 50 percent of eligible costs, but not exceeding \$100,000 per county. Eligible costs typically include collection, transportation and management of the wastes plus education programs. PA DEP (Department of Environmental Protection)	Nonpoint Source Implementation Program Grants (Section 319)	This grant program provides funding to assist in implementing Pennsylvania's Nonpoint Source Management Program. This includes funding for abandoned mine drainage, agricultural and urban run-off, and natural channel design/streambank stabilization projects. PA DEP (Department of Environmental Protection)	Technical Evaluation of HSCA Remedial Response	Section 510 of the Hazardous Sites Cleanup Act, Act 108 of 1988 (HSCA), authorizes DEP to issue Host Municipality Technical Evaluation Grants. A HSCA Host Municipality Technical Evaluation Grant provides funds for conducting an independent technical evaluation of a proposed remedial response at a HSCA site. PA DEP (Department of Environmental Protection)	Recycling Program Development and Implementation Grants	Recycling programs are financed by a \$2-per-ton recycling fee on all waste (except ash) disposed of in landfills or processed by resource recovery facilities in Pennsylvania. Besides grants for local recycling, planning and environmental protection programs, funding subsidizes state programs for recycling market development, public education, technical assistance and grants administration.
