DVRPC	Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ)	Seeks to fund transportation projects that will improve air quality and reduce traffic congestion in the DVRPC Region. CMAQ eligible projects will demonstrably reduce air pollution emissions and will help the DVRPC region meet the federal health based air quality standards.
